DEA's new Multi-factor Authentication

The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) recently implemented two-factor authentication to enhance security of DEA registrations. Any changes to registrations now require inputting a "token," or security code sent to the email listed on the registration. This extra layer helps prevent unauthorized access and strengthens overall security measures within the DEA's systems.



FAWKS Call to Action!

After speaking with a local DEA registration specialist and dealing with frustrations from facilities when a **POC** has left or is unknown, my call to action to contribute to the efficiency of the process & **minimize disruptions** in controlled substance ordering (i.e. DEA 222 forms and CSOS) is:

- Keep the email address on the registration up to date
- Keep the email address accessible even after the individual leaves the facility
- Regularly verify and update contact information
